



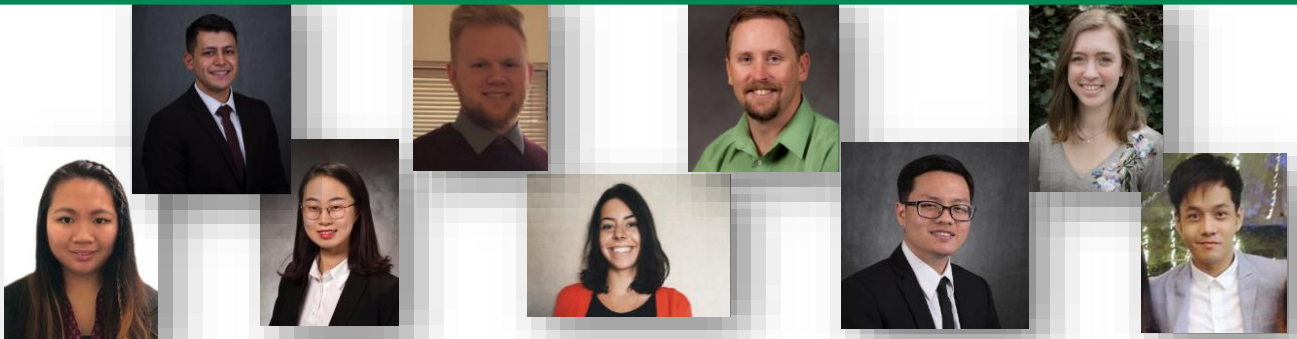

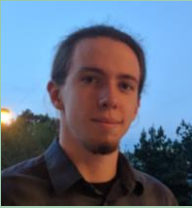

Application deadline:
April 30th

Eligibility for scholarship requirements for all applicants:

- Must be enrolled at an accredited institution for a Facility Management or related field. “Degree” is determined (Associate, Bachelors or Graduate) as defined by your institution at the time of application submission.
- A working student is acceptable
- Must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.2 in FM or related courses or documented confirming academic study achievement is at least 80% of highest grade scale as defined in the student’s country of study.
- Applicants awarded a scholarship are required to attend IFMA’s World Workplace Conference and Exhibition (WW) to be held in Phoenix, Arizona October 15 – 19 in order to receive the scholarship. Travel and associated expenses are part of the scholarship award and offered to students though a single standardized grant. The award also includes full student registration for the conference.


